Introduction

On behalf of the KeyBank Community, the Hispanic/Latino employees of KeyBank will recognize the academic success and community involvement of one Hispanic/Latino college or university student in eight of Key Bank's markets. Since the inception of the HLBKING's scholarship program in 2009, 46 scholarships have been awarded to college juniors and seniors each year.

The 2017 scholarships will be awarded in each of the following KeyBank geographic locations: Capital New York, Central Indiana, Colorado, Hudson Valley, Kansas City, Northeast Ohio, Oregon, Utah, and Washington. Each scholarship will carry the name of KeyBank and the Market's nonprofit partner, for example, 2017 Key Bank/Unidos Bridging Community Scholarship.

Scholarship Description

The KeyBank Latino Scholarship is a one-time scholarship totaling \$1,500. Funding for each scholarship is provided by the Hispanic/Latino Key Business Networking Group Scholarship Program, the KeyBank Foundation, and the KeyBank market where the student resides.

Non-Profit Community Partner

In this region, Key Bank partners with Unidos Bridging Community, a private, non-profit organization based in McMinnville, Oregon. Unidos serves Yamhill County, Oregon and has the following mission:

- To promote the integration, participation, representation, and success of Latino individuals and families in Yamhill County

Applicants must be:

- of Latinx/Hispanic heritage
- enrolled as a full-time student in a four-year accredited college or university
- in Junior or Senior year
- a resident of the Key Bank market awarding the scholarship
- a student in good standing with a cumulative grade point average of 2.8 or higher
- able to demonstrate community service and civic involvement in the Hispanic/Latino community
- willing to be featured in KeyBank related promotions
- **NOT** a current employee of KeyBank

- University/College student verification form on university letterhead or other official designation (p.4)
