1	What are your specific educational plans and career goals and why? What motivates you to achieve them? (Required, 1900 characters maximum)
2	What have you done for your family, school or community that you care about the most and why? (Required, 1900 characters maximum)
3	Describe a personal accomplishment, impactful change, or experience that has occurred in your life. What skills and strengths were needed to respond and what did you learn about yourself? (Required, 1900 characters maximum)
4	(optional) Is there any additional information you would like the selection committee members to know? This could include financial situations not reflected on the FAFSA/ ORSAA or other information not covered in the application. (Required, 1900 characters maximum)

Due Dates:

February 17: Early bird deadline (entered for one of many \$1,000 scholarships, varies yearly)

March 2: Final Deadline

March 31: Last day for transcript corrections
